



## 30-Day Prayer Calendar—Kentucky

**April 5**—Call on the Name of the Lord and pray for forgiveness. Ask the Lord to revive our hearts and souls. *Jeremiah 29:12–14*

**April 6**—Pray for the Lord to help us, our families, and our churches live out biblical principles in every area of life. *Psalms 121*

**April 7**—Pray for the church in **Kentucky** to be steadfast, strong, and abounding in the work of the Lord. *1 Corinthians 15:58*

**April 8**—Pray for the Holy Spirit to give wisdom on how to pray for the specific needs of the people in **Kentucky**. *Romans 8:26*

**April 9**—Pray for the church to have a renewed revelation of Jesus Christ’s sacrifice on the cross. *Ephesians 2:4*

**April 10**—Pray for unity among all the churches in **Kentucky**. *Romans 15:5–7*

**April 11**—Pray for the salvation of all in **Kentucky** who have yet to know the love of God. *John 3:16–17*

**April 12**—Pray for the church in **Kentucky** to be steadfast in love and faithfulness to one another. *Proverbs 3:3–4*

**April 13**—Pray that God will continue to place men and women of faith in positions of authority within our government and that they will continue to live holy lives. *Proverbs 16:17–18*

**April 14**—Pray for all people in **Kentucky**, in every sphere of public and private life, to hear the Gospel and be saved. *Romans 10:9–10*

**April 15**—Pray for the church in **Kentucky** to share the Gospel and disciple new believers effectively. *Matthew 28:18–20*

**April 16**—Pray for elected local officials to support biblical values on all local issues in **Kentucky**. *Proverbs 21:1–3*

**April 17**—Pray that we, personally, will live authentic and godly lives, seeking revival first in our own hearts. *Romans 14:17*

**April 18**—Pray for the needs of those suffering in your city: the homeless, poor, sick, and lonely. *Romans 12:20*

**April 19**—Pray that Christians would be salt and light, living godly lives in home and in public. *Matthew 5:13–16*

**April 20**—Pray for the safety of those serving our country in the military. Pray for encouragement and strength as they are away from their families and for a safe return home. *Psalms 91*

**April 21**—Pray that Christians who serve in public and elected positions in **Kentucky** would be directed by the Holy Spirit. *1 Timothy 2:1–4*

**April 22**—Pray for safety from violence, evil, and pride. Ask that God will unite the church. *1 Corinthians 1:10*

**April 23**—Pray for pastors to have boldness as they proclaim the Gospel and lead congregations in **Kentucky**. *Acts 9:28*

**April 24**—Pray for the church to be aware of areas of sin, to be cleansed where there is error, and to be established where there is good. *Ephesians 4:1–3*

**April 25**—Pray for Christians to repent of sin and experience a season of revival from the Lord. *Acts 3:19*

**April 26**—Pray for a renewed revelation of God's Word that leads to an authentic love for God and holy living. *Hebrews 4:12*

**April 27**—Pray for pastors and families in **Kentucky** to be strengthened. *1 Corinthians 9:16*

**April 28**—Pray for Christians to be salt and light to **Kentucky** through humble hearts, acts of service, and the sharing of the Gospel. *John 13:34–35*

**April 29**—Pray for wisdom for individuals in leadership as they make decisions for communities and the nation. *James 1:5*

**April 30**—Pray for strength for God's people to uphold justice and stand against sin in the world. *Psalms 7*

**May 1**—Pray for peace and calmness in the streets and neighborhoods of **Kentucky**. *Matthew 5:9*

**May 2**—Pray for the Lord to guide the leaders of all nations and help them bring truth and light into the world. *Colossians 1:9*

**May 3**—Pray for Franklin Graham as he brings God's message to the state of **Kentucky** and the nation and ask that Jesus will be glorified in all we do. *Acts 1:8*

**May 4**—Pray for revival in our cities, our states, our nation, and all nations. *Psalms 51:10–12*
